





Evaluation of periodontal parameters

- Attachmentlevel
- Plaque index
- Bleeding on probing(BOP)
- Sounding on alveolar crest


- Generalized mild inflammation
- Generalized moderate perio
- Bleeding on probing +, pockets depths 4 to 6 in posterior region before treatment
- Parafunctional habits
- Lack of posterior support
- Moderate horizontal bone loss
- Singular recessions
- Severe occlusal and cervical abrasion
- Severe loss in VDO
- Generalized Class I mobilities
- CR \neq CO
- 0.5 mm anterior shift
- Angle Class I









Initial x-ray /FMX 2005
